#### Education Series

The Education Series will be Jan. 21 and 22<sup>nd</sup> at Sprint headquarters. Level 1 Coaching clinic will be Saturday for Men's and Women's. Level two for Men will be Sunday. Registration is up at [uslacrosse.org](http://uslacrosse.org). The \$1500 Grant is subsidizing \$20 of the fee for all three clinics. Lunch is \$6 and we are bringing it in again. Holly and Mike are getting volunteers from Prairie Village, Lancer and Northland to assist over the two days.

#### Girls Coaching Clinic with Lauren Taylor

This clinic will be taught by Lauren Taylor from Yale. Lauren is a current Yale coach and has numerous honors while at Yale. It is December 17th from 1 – 4 pm at Go Sports at 95<sup>th</sup> and Lackman. The fee is \$25. We hope to get 25 women coaches there. The facility fee is \$100 and her fee is \$250.

It was mentioned that we need a list of all facilities in the area for people to view. Holly will start a list and pass out to add and update.

## **Website**

Julie talked about going to the US Lacrosse Website. Different access levels can be set up for users to do updates. It is free to host. We have paid godaddy \$300 to register and host the site. We would get some of that back if we moved over to US Lax site. On the US Lax site we will automatically get US Lacrosse information.

## **Umpire Grant**

Julie Wittman presented a proposal to us for \$250 to reimburse them to send her to US Lacrosse Convention for Umpire training. WE can pay after we received our next deposit from US lacrosse. They received scholarship from US lacrosse as well. John Bartel asked what happens if they did not go. Julie stated it was not recommended to miss the required training. We voted in favor of giving her the \$250.

Lydia went over the formation of the Girls League that will encompass youth and high school. They are meeting this Saturday.

## **Board Structuring**

Justine presented his plan for a structuring of the board. Each director and officer would serve on one of three committees. The purpose is to ensure each director and officer has a designated role to fill. This could help us achieve our stated goals. Eric Olson stated we need to tap into knew people. Julie mentioned this would bring more accountability. Jay mentioned that we need to use "sponsored by US Lacrosse" more to ensure people in the community know events are put on the US Lacrosse chapter.

It was discussed and motioned that is be tables for now.

## **Bylaw Change**

Eric Olson reviewed his bylaw change proposal. His request is the modification to the Bylaw to remove the statement "***Only directors of the corporation shall be eligible to serve as officers***" These bylaws seem fairly stringent and tied to a corporate for-profit structure and would stifle the opportunity for an individual who could be more than qualified to fulfill the role of an officer. Additionally I don't think the Great Plains chapter is in a position to limit the potential possible candidates who willing commit their time to grow the chapter and the game as well as finding someone who is willing to step up that is not tied to a team or special interest party, i.e. ESB, Blue Lion, Orange, True, Stickstop, etc.

This provided opportunities for parents or unaffiliated body to come in and be an officer. Eric Koford motioned we remove the sentence. The motioned was 2<sup>nd</sup> and the vote passed 6 to 3.

## **Elections for Officers and Directors –**

With the bylaw change passed John Bartel was nominated for President along with Justin.

Justin spoke about his accomplishments the last two years and how he would like to continue as President.

A ballot vote took place and John won the majority.
